

ALPHABET OUTDOORS

Literacy - EYFS, KS1

Optional resources: laminated or wood cookie letters, a white board & pen for each child, sand trays, pots of water, camera for recording evidence.

HANGING LETTERS

Hang up some letters around the grounds, out of children's reach.

- Can the children find and stand next to the initial letter of their name?
- Can they find the initial letter of their friend's name?
- Choose a simple word. Ask a child to spell out the word by visiting the letters in turn.



ALPHABET SCAVENGER HUNT

Challenge children to identify something they can see, smell, hear or touch beginning with certain letters of the alphabet.

Ask them to draw the object on their white board and have a go at writing the letter or even the name of the object. How much of the alphabet can they complete?

MARK MAKING

Use a stick to draw letters in mud or trays of sand. Alternatively, dip the stick in some water (perhaps a puddle) to draw on the playground.



NATURAL LETTERS

Arrange sticks, leaves or other natural materials to form letters or even spell words.
