



Updated 21 April 2021

Step one of the government's roadmap has seen school life starting to return to normal with full school opening.

The government recognises the significance of school trips, and, as such, has outlined a phased approach, in line with its roadmap, to reintroduce them.

As of 12 April 2021, we have entered step two of the plan, which will see the return of daytime school trips.

Step three, scheduled for the 17 May 2021, will see the return of residential trips.

For all visitors to Suntrap it is important to note that the government's plan is provisional, and they have ensured that it will only move from one step to the next when it is safe to do so. The government has emphasised that the roadmap is driven by data and not dates, meaning the dates in our guidance could be subject to change.

Therefore anyone planning future trips should do so with caution, always making sure they have a contingency plan in place in case the government's current roadmap is forced to change.
