

Environmental Policy

Suntrap Forest Centre commits itself to:

- Communicate its environmental policy and strategy to staff and service users and to raise awareness amongst these groups of their own environmental responsibilities and requirement to commit to environmental improvements;
- Protect, develop & enhance natural habitats and encourage local wildlife and biological diversity of the Centre's managed land;
- Implement measures to encourage walking, cycling and the use of public transport to access the site;
- Reduce waste created and where possible to reuse and recycle before responsible disposal of surplus materials. Use recycled and recyclable materials wherever possible;
- Manage and reduce water consumption through the use of water harvesting from our buildings and water saving devices;
- Integrate principles of environmental sustainability within all teaching & learning, policies and practices, including those relating to procurement of goods and services;
- Avoid or limit the use of environmentally-damaging substances, materials and processes wherever practical;
- Work with partners to realise environmental projects.

Progress on implementing all areas of the policy and the Environmental Sustainability Strategy will be reviewed annually by Suntrap staff. The policy itself is subject to annual review. Review date February 2022.
